

Coaches & Directors: Play Hard Hoops takes seriously the decision to play this weekend's games to close out the Play Hard Travel Feeder Season. At the moment we have not heard from any facilities that they are shutting down their operations. We are using two schools: Millburn School – Lindenhurst and Woodlawn Middle School – Long Grove. Both schools are certainly doing everything to make sure their schools are clean and safe, so I am very comfortable with the safety of the school facilities hosting the tourney. Canlan Sportsplex is taking all appropriate measures and we have enclosed their measures to ensure the safety of its customers, vendors, etc.

Here are areas that Play Hard will be working to ensure on game day:

CURRENTLY, ALL GAMES WILL PROCEED AS SCHEDULED. Because precaution is the best policy, we request that teams follow the guidelines set forth below when participating in our events.

- Have each player bring their own source of water – please mark your water bottle with your name. (Plain water bottles and Gatorade bottles should not be on the benches)
- Do not use water fountains – buy bottled water and fill up your individual water bottle
- We will be looking to have hand sanitizer on scorers tables and there is sanitizer on the walls at the gym locations for families
- We will have gloves on the scorers tables for parents handling the scoreboard and scoresheets
- All Concessions and admissions personnel will wear gloves
- We request that the same parent who is not feeling any symptoms of cold, flu, etc be the parent volunteer for the scorers table to limit the amount of people at the scorers table
- Teams will be required to clean their bench of all items: clothing, water bottles, etc before the next team utilizes the bench area
- We will sanitize the concessions area consistently by wiping down tables and benches

PLAY HARD ASKS THAT FAMILIES KEEP HOME ANY SIBLINGS OR FAMILY MEMBERS THAT HAVE BEEN SICK WITHIN THE LAST 2 WEEKS. WHILE WE WILL NOT TURN AWAY GRANDPARENTS, THE ELDERLY ARE THE MOST VULNERABLE AND FAMILIES SHOULD CONSIDER NOT HAVING GRANDPARENTS ATTEND GAMES.

- Remind players to cover their mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing. Sanitize afterward.
- Remind players to wash their hands with soap or hand sanitizer after every game.
- Remind players to avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth.
- If anyone is showing flu-like symptoms, or if you are uncomfortable having them participate in organized activities, please keep them home.
- As appropriate, contact your healthcare provider.
